Dear Mr. John Bibbo:

Carrera Designs, Inc. was issued a Title V permit ( T039-7512-00326) on December 31, 1998 for operating a stationary custom bus and bus skirt coating source. A letter requesting changes in the several conditions of the permit was received on February 23, 1999. Pursuant to the provisions of 2-7-11 the permit is hereby administratively amended as follows:

The condition D.1.6 of the permit requires compliance with condition D.1.2 at the end of each month based on total volatile organic compound usage for the most recent twelve(12) months. The Permittee was requesting to add a statement to condition D.1.6 to allow for thirty (30) days after the end of the month to complete the necessary record keeping and calculations to demonstrate compliance. The condition D.1.10 allows up to thirty (30) days after the end of each quarter for reporting requirements: this condition (D.1.10) shall take precedence over condition D.1.6 where record keeping shall be demonstrated at the end of each month based on the total volatile organic compound usage for the most recent twelve (12) months.

Condition D.1.9(a)(1) was requested to be changed because there is no limit on the operation which requires there to be a segregation of emissions between coatings and solvents. This condition will be changed. Condition D.1.9(a)(2) was requested to be changed to make it consistent with other monthly recording in the permit. The wording will be changed.

The conditions D.1.9 (a)(1) and D.1.9(a)(2) of the permit shall be amended as follows(changes in bold):

**D.1.9 Record Keeping Requirements**

(a) To document compliance with Condition D.1.2, the Permittee shall maintain records in accordance with (1) through (6) below. Records maintained for (1) through (6) shall be taken monthly and shall be complete and sufficient to establish compliance with the VOC usage limit established in Conditions D.1.2.

- (1) The amount and VOC content of each coating material and solvent used. Records shall include purchase orders, invoices, and material safety data sheets (MSDS) necessary to verify the

type and amount used. ~~Solvent usage records shall differentiate between those added to coatings and those used as cleanup solvents;~~

- (2) A log of the ~~dates~~ **month** of use;

All other conditions of the permit shall remain unchanged and in effect. Please attach a copy of this amendment with the original permit.

(Clean Air Act as amended by the 1990 Clean Air Act Amendments), 40 CFR Part 70.6, IC 13-15 and IC 13-17.

- (b) Monthly inspections shall be performed of the coating emissions from the stack and the presence of overspray on the rooftops and the nearby ground. The Compliance Response Plan for this unit shall contain troubleshooting contingency and response steps for when a noticeable change in overspray emission, or evidence of overspray emission is observed. The Compliance Response Plan shall be followed whenever a condition exists which should result in a response step. Failure to take response steps in accordance with Section C - Compliance Monitoring Plan - Failure to Take Response Steps, shall be considered a violation of this permit.
- (c) Additional inspections and preventive measures shall be performed as prescribed in the Preventive Maintenance Plan.

### **Record Keeping and Reporting Requirements [326 IAC 2-7-5(3)] [326 IAC 2-7-19]**

#### D.1.9 Record Keeping Requirements

- (a) To document compliance with Condition D.1.2, the Permittee shall maintain records in accordance with (1) through (6) below. Records maintained for (1) through (6) shall be taken monthly and shall be complete and sufficient to establish compliance with the VOC usage limit established in Conditions D.1.2.
  - (1) The amount and VOC content of each coating material and solvent used. Records shall include purchase orders, invoices, and material safety data sheets (MSDS) necessary to verify the type and amount used;
  - (2) A log of the month of use;
  - (3) The volume weighted VOC content of the coatings used for each month;
  - (4) The cleanup solvent usage for each month;
  - (5) The total VOC usage for each day month; and
  - (6) The weight of VOCs emitted for each compliance period.
- (b) To document compliance with Condition D.1.7 and D.1.8, the Permittee shall maintain a log of weekly overspray observations, daily and monthly inspections, and those additional inspections prescribed by the Preventive Maintenance Plan.
- (c) All records shall be maintained in accordance with Section C - General Record Keeping Requirements, of this permit.

#### D.1.10 Reporting Requirements

A quarterly summary of the information to document compliance with Condition D.1.2 shall be submitted to the address listed in Section C - General Reporting Requirements, of this permit, using the reporting forms located at the end of this permit, or their equivalent, within thirty (30) days after the end of the quarter being reported.
