- (b) To document compliance with Condition D.1.5, the Permittee shall maintain records demonstrating actions have been taken to fulfill the Work Practice Implementation Plan.
- (c) All records shall be maintained in accordance with Section C - General Record Keeping Requirements, of this permit.

D.1.16 Reporting Requirements

- (a) A quarterly summary of the information to document compliance with Condition D.1.1 shall be submitted to the address listed in Section C - General Reporting Requirements, of this permit, using the reporting forms located at the end of this permit, or their equivalent, within thirty (30) days after the end of the quarter being reported.
- (b) An Initial Compliance Report to document compliance with Condition D.1.4 and the Certification form, shall be submitted within sixty (60) days following the compliance date of December 7, 1998. The Initial Compliance Report must include data from the entire month that the compliance date falls.
- (c) A semi-annual Continuous Compliance Report to document compliance with Condition D.1.4 and the Certification form, shall be submitted within thirty (30) days after the end of the six (6) months being reported.

The six (6) month periods shall cover the following months:

- (1) January 1 through June 30.
- (2) July 1 through December 31.
- (d) The reports required in (b) and (c) of this condition shall be submitted to:
