Dear Mr. Berg:

Your letter, requesting both review and confirmation regarding whether Section D.2 (pages 35 and 36) of the Jasper Seating Part 70 permit (037-5805) had been removed due to the issuance of the significant source modification (037-10701), was received on December 8, 1999. For historical background:

- (a) Title V permit (037-5803) was issued on December 28, 1999 with section D.2 of the permit treating the woodworking operation as a significant activity with corresponding limitations and compliance reporting conditions. Specific conditions indicated in the permit are: visible emission notations, baghouse inspections, broken bag detection requirements, compliance monitoring plan, and record keeping requirements.
- (b) Title V Significant Source Modification (037-10701) involved the re-evaluation of the woodworking operations. From the review, the woodworking operations were reclassified to an insignificant activity. In the Significant Source Modification which was issued on May 19, 1999 the woodworking activities were moved in the Title V permit to Section A.3(b)(Insignificant Activities).

Therefore, all of section D.2 of the permit is no longer applicable to the source. Pursuant to the significant source modification (037-10701) section D.2 (pages 35 and 36) are removed from the Part 70 permit and all pages and conditions renumbered accordingly.
