Dear Mr. Crone:

Approval is hereby granted to operate the portable ready-mix concrete batch plant, INDOT No. 01654, described in Operation Permit No. S005-6351-01654 issued on September 16, 1996. This source is to be located at the INDOT right-of-way at I-465 and East 56th Street, within the southwest loop of the interchange, Indianapolis, in Marion County, Indiana. This plant was previously located at the property owned by Lick Creek Construction, 305 Garstag, Indianapolis, in Marion County, Indiana. The site approval for the property owned by Lick Creek Construction, 305 Garstag, Indianapolis, Indiana was issued on May 14, 1999.

Relocation of this plant must take place within 120 days after the issuance of this decision. The enclosed Notice of Decision explains your options to challenge this decision under IC 4-21.5-3-5(f). Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-5(f), this approval is not effective until eighteen (18) days from the date of this letter. This approval supersedes all previous site approval letters.

Advance written notice to the Office of Air Management (OAM), Air Compliance Section, and Indianapolis Environmental Resources Division of start-up is required in order for the Indianapolis Environmental Resources Division to perform an inspection. If the plant is not operating in compliance with all applicable regulations upon inspection, the plant must cease operation upon notification to you by OAM staff of such non-compliance. Operations may only resume once remedial actions have been taken and approved by the OAM.
