Dear Mr. Bundant:

Independent Concrete Pipe was issued a permit on January 21, 2000 for a concrete batch mixing operation. A letter notifying the Office of Air Management of a request for a revision of R 059-11637-00025 was received on March 27, 2000. Pursuant to the provisions of 326 IAC 2-6.1-6, Condition #3 of the permit is hereby revised as follows:

To document compliance with Condition #1, the Permittee shall maintain records of weekly visible emissions notations of the dust collectors for the three storage silos, units 004, 005 and 006.

Since the concrete batch mixer #2 is not vented to the outdoors, weekly visible emissions notations are not necessary for the mixer #2. The pressure drop requirements shall not be applicable to the dust collectors for the silos because the actual pressure drop is highly variable. This is due to the fact that the dust collectors do not contain blowers to develop a negative pressure, rather, air is forced through the dust collectors due to the air being displaced by material that is pumped into the silos. The pumping of material into the silos is highly variable resulting in a large pressure drop range.

All other conditions of the permit shall remain unchanged and in effect. Please attach a copy of this letter to the front of the original permit.
