Dear Dale A. Boyer:

Reese Products, Inc. was issued a permit on July 19, 1999 for processing motor vehicle parts. A letter notifying the Office of Air Management of an error in the Technical Support Document (TSD) for this registration was received on April 20, 2000. Pursuant to the provisions of 326 IAC 2-5.5-6 (d)(1) the permit is hereby revised as follows:

1. The TSD erroneously states that the application was submitted by Beaver Oil Company, Inc. This should be changed to Reese Products, Inc.

OAM does not normally make corrections to the TSD and create a new document. This change will be noted and placed in the files.

2. The Permittee had also requested to modify conditions related to the operation of burn-off oven under section 4 of this registration.

The conditions described under this section are pursuant to rule 326 IAC 4-2-2 (Incinerators), and the wording change requested are part of the standard rule language. Since the rule language cannot be changed, the wording changes will not be made

All other conditions of the permit shall remain unchanged and in effect. Please attach a copy of this letter to the front of the permit. No changes have been made to the registration related to this notice only change.
