Dear Mr. Bloomer:

Acetylene Products was issued a Source Specific Operating Agreement (SSOA) on October 28, 1999 for an SSOA under 326 IAC 2-9-5 (SSOA: Abrasive Cleaning Operations). A letter requesting a name change from Acetylene Products to Praxair Gas Tech was received from Praxair Gas Tech on June 5, 2000. In response to a June 16, 2000 Notice of Deficiency letter from the City of Indianapolis Environmental Resources Management Division (ERMD), Praxair Gas Tech responded in writing July 10, 2000 that Praxair Gas Tech should not be considered the same source as Praxair Surface Technologies (F097-7487-00060), even though the two sources are adjacent and/or contiguous, because the two sources have different Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) Codes (34 versus 51) and neither operation controls the operations of the other site or provides a support relationship to the other source. As a result, the name of the source operating under S097-5131-00189 is being changed from Acetylene Products to Praxair Gas Tech pursuant to this First Administrative Amendment to S097-5131-00189.

The SSOA is hereby administratively amended as follows:

Dear ~~F. J. Klepek~~ **Mr. Bloomer**:

Your application for Source Specific Operation Status was received on December 13, 1995 and has been reviewed. Based on the data submitted and the provisions in Section 1 of 326 IAC 2-1, it has been determined that your emission source, an abrasive cleaning operation located at ~~Acetylene Products Company~~ **Praxair Gas Tech**, 1400 Polco Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46222 has met the criteria required to obtain a Source Specific Operating Agreement.

Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-5(a) and (b), approval of this Source Specific Operating Agreement shall not be effective until fifteen (15) days from the date of this letter.

The facilities and processes of this source are hereby granted the Source Specific Operating Agreement provided that the following requirements of 326 IAC 2-9 are satisfied:

Section A: Abrasive Cleaning Operation: [326 IAC 2-9-5]

1. The units of the abrasive cleaning operation shall be totally enclosed.

2. The particulate matter (PM) emissions from the abrasive cleaning operation shall not exceed one-hundredth (0.01) grain per actual cubic foot of outlet air.
3. The exhaust air flow rate of the abrasive cleaning operation shall not exceed forty thousand (40,000) actual cubic feet of outlet air per minute.
4. The source shall maintain records of the types of air pollution control devices utilized at the source and the abrasive cleaning operation, and the operation and maintenance manuals for those devices.

Section B: General Requirements: [326 IAC 2-9-1]

1. The source shall provide an annual notice to the commissioner, stating that the source is in operation, and certifying that its operations are in compliance with the requirements of this Source Specific Operating Agreement. The above annual notice shall be submitted to:

no later than January 30 of each year, with the annual notice being submitted in the format attached.

2. Any exceedance of any requirement contained in this operating agreement shall be reported, in writing, within one (1) week of its occurrence. Said report shall include information on the actions taken to correct the exceedance, including measures to reduce emissions, in order to comply with the established limits. If an exceedance is the result of a malfunction, then the provisions of 326 IAC 1-6 apply.
3. Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-9-1(i), the owner or operator is hereby notified that this operating agreement does not relieve the permittee of the responsibility to comply with the provisions of any applicable federal, state, or local rules, or any New Source Performance Standards (NSPS), 40 CFR Part 60, or National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP), 40 CFR Part 61.

Any change or modification which will alter operations in such a way that it will no longer comply with the applicable restrictions and conditions of this operating agreement, must obtain the appropriate approval from the Environmental Resource Management Division (ERMD) and the Office of Air Management (OAM) under 326 IAC 2-1, 326 IAC 2-2, 326 IAC 2-3, 326 IAC 2-7, and 326 IAC 2-8, before such change may occur.
