Dear Mr. Kohlmann:

Citizens Gas & Coke Utility was issued a Construction Permit CP-0980061-01 on July 1, 1998 for Battery 2 and associated equipment for the manufacture of coke, which will replace the existing Battery E and Battery H and associated equipment at 2950 East Prospect Street in Indianapolis.

The City of Indianapolis Environmental Resources Management Division (ERMD) by your request issued an Administrative Amendment on November 17, 1999, to amend the Construction Condition 4 of CP-0980061-01 with extension of the Battery 2 construction commencement date for a period at least one (1) additional year, until December 2000.

On July 28, 2000 ERMD received your request for an additional extension of the Battery 2 construction commencement for 18 months beyond December 31, 2000. The request to extend the deadline was made by Citizens Gas & Coke Utility because financial negotiations for Battery 2 and associated equipment construction have not been completed as of the date of the request.

Construction Condition 4 stated the Administrator may revoke the permit if construction was not commenced within eighteen (18) months after permit issuance. The eighteen month period is set to expire on January 1, 2000.

ERMD is initiating the second Administrative Amendment to the Construction Permit CP-0980061-01 by revising Construction Condition 4 of the July 1, 1998 Construction Permit. By way of this Administrative Amendment 097-12575-00061, the deadline to commence construction is extended to no later than August 1, 2002. The amended Construction Condition 4, with additions in bold face type, now states:

4. That pursuant to IAPCB Regulation 2 and 326 IAC 2-1.1-9(5), the Administrator may revoke this permit if construction is not commenced ~~prior to December 31, 2000~~ **prior to August 1, 2002** or if construction is suspended for a continuous period of one (1) year or more.

All other conditions of CP0980061-01 remain unchanged and in effect. Please attach a copy of this Administrative Amendment 097-12575-00061 to the original Construction Permit.
