Dear Mr. Ledbetter:

On January 18, 2001, Foertsch Construction Co., Inc., notified the Office of Air of Quality (OAQ) that the Foertsch Mine No. 2, located at SR 70 and County Road 475 East, Newtonville, Indiana, has ceased mining, thus eliminating the need for an operating permit.

The Source Specific State Operating (SSOA)147- 8099-00031, issued on February 3, 1998, is hereby revoked. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-5(a) and (b), this revocation letter is effective eighteen (18) days from the date of this letter.

Any construction or modification that would result to potential to emit greater than the exemption levels, as specified in 326 IAC 2-1.1-3 (Exemptions) shall be subject to New Source Review (NSR) and must be approved by the OAM before such construction or modification may occur.
