Dear Ms. Maenhout:

Vulcan Construction Materials, LP Battleground facility (a sand and gravel plant) was issued a Source Specific Operating Agreement (S 157-7498-00069) on December 26, 1996. A letter requesting the approval for the addition of a stacking conveyor was received on March 14, 2001. The Source Specific Operating Agreement (SSOA) is hereby administratively amended as follows:

The addition of a stacking conveyor to be part of the conveying operation, in order to minimize material handling. The sand and gravel plant now consists of one feeder, five conveyors, and one double-deck screen.

The current SSOA allows the facility to have up to twelve crushers, twenty-four screens, and a conveying operation not to exceed 3.1 million tons annually. The additional equipment will not exceed these restrictions.

All other conditions of the permit shall remain unchanged and in effect. Please attach a copy of this amendment and the following revised permit pages to the front of the original permit.
