Dear Shane A. Spencer:

The letter from IMCO Recycling of Indiana, received on March 15, 2001, has been reviewed. This letter requested that Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit (FESOP) 093-5491-00009 be revoked. This permit was issued for operation of a secondary aluminum reclamation source.

The Permittee has ceased operations of all emission units covered in this permit. Therefore, the Permittee has requested for revoking this FESOP and all subsequent permit revisions and amendments to this FESOP.

The FESOP 093-5491-00009, issued on December 12, 1996 is hereby revoked. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-5 (a) and (b), this revocation letter is effective eighteen (18) days from the date of this letter.

Any construction or modification that would result in potential to emit of any criteria pollutant greater than the exemption threshold, as specified in 326 IAC 2-1.1-3 (Exemptions) shall be subject to New Source Review (NSR) and must be approved by this office before such construction or modification may occur.
