Dear Mr. Costoplos:

David R. Webb Co., Inc. applied for a Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit (FESOP) on April 5, 2000 relating to the operation of a veneer manufacturing facility. The FESOP is currently under OAQ's review. A letter dated March 15, 2001 requested that the existing 60 MMBtu per hour waste wood burning steam generating boiler, identified as Boiler 02, permitted under CP 081-2582-00014, be also allowed to burn waste wood fuel from another manufacturer in addition to the currently allowed waste wood fuel from the veneer manufacturing operation at the source. The use of this supplementary waste wood fuel will not result in an increase in utilization of Boiler 02. The waste wood fuel from the outside source consists of primarily untreated crating material, wood chips and occasionally particleboard. Pursuant to the provisions of 326 IAC 2-8-10 the permit is hereby administratively amended as follows:

IDEM, OAQ has determined that supplementing the existing waste wood with the use of waste wood from an outside source does not increase the potential to emit of any regulated pollutant based on AP-42, Chapter 1.6, emission factors for wood-fired boilers. There is no change to the pending FESOP as a result of this change.

All other conditions of the permit shall remain unchanged and in effect. Please attach a copy of this amendment to the front of the original permit.
