Response to Request for Review the Letter
Of April 6, 2001

Dear Jim Henderson:

On April 6, 2001, you submitted a request to the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) to review the status of your operation. Specifically, the request asked whether OAQ agreed with the determination that the source would qualify for an Source Specific Operating Agreement (SSOA) under 326 IAC 2-9-13 or Permit by Rule under 326 IAC 2-10-1.

326 IAC 2-9-13(b)(2)(A) and (c) states that if the source can be limited to less than the values in Table 1, then an SSOA is not required for these sources. The values in Table 1 for natural gas fired sources with a capacity between 10 and 100 MMBTU/hr are 181 MMCF of natural gas. The source has a capacity of 70.2 MMBTU/hr. The letter states that the source has used less than 90 MMCF in each of the past three years.

326 IAC 2-10-3 states that the source has to have actual emissions less than 20% of the Title V levels. The letter states that the pollutant with the most emissions is NOx. Its emissions were 4.4 tons per year in 1999.

Based upon this data, it would be correct that the source would fall under one of these options.
