Dear Mr. Smith:

The letter from Colwell General Inc., received on May 11, 2001, has been reviewed. This letter related to the plant located at 200 Sixth Street, Fort Wayne, Indiana 46808. This letter requested that Part 70 permit No. 003-6021-00005 be revoked. The reason for this revocation request is that the production operations at the Fort Wayne plant have been relocated to a sister facility in Kendallville, Indiana. The Faustel paper coating line, identified as CC-1, has been added to the Part 70 Permit No. T113-6020-00019 for the Kendallville facility in Significant Permit Modification No. 113-11120-00019. The Transco paper coating line, identified as CC-2, never existed, and was erroneously included in permit no. T003-6021-00005 for the Fort Wayne facility.

Pursuant to rule 326 IAC 2-1.1-9, any permit to construct or operate or any permit revision approval granted by the commissioner may be revoked for any other cause that establishes in the judgement of the commissioner the fact that continuance of the permit or permit revision approval is not consistent with the purposes of this article. Since the facility is no longer in operation, the Part 70 permit will be revoked.
