Dear Mr. Krull:

United Technologies - Otis Elevator was issued a Part 70 permit on February 19, 1999, for a stationary elevator and escalator manufacturing plant. The letter was submitted to determine if United Technologies - Otis Elevator requires an air pollution permit for operations consisting of:

Insignificant Activities

- (a) Storage tanks with capacity less than or equal to 1,000 gallons and annual throughputs less than 1,200 gallons.
- (b) Closed loop heating and cooling system.

Criteria pollutant threshold levels for exemptions are as follows:

PM10 = <5tpy; **SO2** = <10 tpy; **NOx** = <10 tpy; **VOC** <10 tpy for sources not required to use air pollution control devices to comply with 328 IAC 8; **VOC** <5 tpy for sources required to use air pollution control devices to comply with 326 IAC 8; **CO** = < 25 tpy.

The insignificant activities are listed under 2-7-1.1(21)(G)(iii)(AA) and (vi)(FF), respectively. There are no regulations or rules applicable to these insignificant activities, thus these insignificant activities will be kept in IDEM, OAQ records and are not added to the issued Part 70 permit.

If a source can comply with exempt levels, the burden of proof lies with the source. If the source requires a definite decision to be made by the IDEM and a permit be issued, filing fees and any other permit fees shall be applicable according to the level of permit required.
