Dear Mr. Carlisle:

Meilink Safe Company, located at 101 Security Parkway, New Albany, Indiana 47150, was issued a FESOP permit (F043-11524-00043) on February 23, 2000, for a commercial storage safe manufacturing operation. In a letter received by IDEM-OAQ on July 31, 2001, Meilink Safe Company requested an extension period that would begin August 24, 2001 and run through February 23, 2002 to begin construction of EU-17, a powdercoat line. This powdercoat line has been permitted as an insignificant activity in the FESOP.

No new Federal or State Rules have been implemented since FESOP permit issuance that would require additional review of these facilities. Further, there are no unresolved compliance issues or enforcement actions pending for this source. Therefore, additional review of these facilities is not required. Therefore, the commencement of construction for EU-17, a powdercoat line has been extended to February 23, 2002.
