Dear Mr. Knip:

Walsh & Kelly, Inc. was issued a federally enforceable state operation permit (FESOP) on July 17, 1997 for a portable hot mix asphalt plant located at the northeast corner of I-65 and S.R. 10 near Demotte, Indiana. A letter requesting revocation of the permit was received on October 12, 2001. The request was made to inform OAQ that the portable plant has been sold and permanently relocated by its new owner outside of Indiana.

Rule 326 IAC 2-1.1-9 states that any permit to construct or operate may be revoked for any cause that establishes in the judgment of the commissioner the fact that continuance of the permit is not consistent with the purposes of 326 IAC 2.

Pursuant to the provisions of 326 IAC 2-1.1-9, the permit is hereby revoked due to the fact that the portable emission source, which will no longer locate in Indiana, is no longer subject to 326 IAC 2-8.
