Dear Anil Joshi:

Textron Automotive Company was issued a Title V permit on September 16, 1999 for a plastic automotive parts manufacturing and finishing operation. A letter requesting a change in the dry filter systems of their existing coating booths was received on November 15, 2001. Pursuant to the provisions of 2-7-11(a)(8), the permit is hereby administratively amended as follows:

Textron Automotive has submitted an application to replace their existing dry filter systems of coating booths E, HS14, HS15, ZJR, and ZJM, with more efficient dry filters. Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-7-11, the addition of the proposed dry filter systems is hereby acknowledged. No revision of the permit is necessary to accommodate the change, as the proposed filter systems do not:

- (a) allow an increase in any air pollutant emissions,
- (b) allow an increase in the capacities or throughputs of the respective coating booths, or
- (c) trigger any new requirements or changes to any existing conditions.

All conditions of the permit shall remain unchanged and in effect. Please attach a copy of this letter to the front of the original permit.
