Dear Mr. O'Toole:

On November 26, 2001, the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) received your request for a change relative to Permit S 073-11315-00004 for operation of your stationary crushed stone processing plant located at 701 East Emmett Avenue, Rensselaer, Indiana 47978.

Babcock Stone has installed, in their stone crushing operation, a double deck wash screen the purpose of which is to screen water and sediment out of their product.

In the request Babcock Stone stated that:

- 1) The addition of this screen will not cause them to exceed the maximum number of screens allowed by their SSOA. The addition of this screen will give them a total of 5 screens - they are permitted for thirteen (13) screens.
- 2) With the addition of this screen, the process material will still have a moisture content greater than one and five tenths percent (1.5%), therefore the operation will still be in compliance with 326 IAC 2-9-8 SSOA (Crushed Stone Processing Plants).
- 3) Because it is a wet screening operation, the addition of this screen will not require Method 9 New Source Performance Standards testing or notification requirements under 40 CFR 60.675(h)(1).
- 4) It is Babcock Stones understanding that should they subsequently process dry material, they would be required to notify Office of Air Quality and conduct the appropriate test found in Method 9.

Based on the above information, with the addition of the above described double deck wash screen Babcock Stones crushed stone operation still meets the conditions of 326 IAC 2-9-8 SSOA (Crushed Stone Processing Plants), no additional permitting approvals are required. Since the screening apparatus is wet, under 40 CFR Subsection 60.675(h)(1) this is not required to be tested, thus there are no additional testing requirements.

All other conditions of SSOA 073-11315-00004 remain unchanged and in effect.

The application and enforcement of these standards have been delegated to the IDEM, OAQ. The requirements of 40 CFR Part 60 are also federally enforceable
