Dear Mr. John Schroer :

On January 22, 2002, the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) received an interim significant source modification petition from American Woodmark located at 5300 East Side Parkway, Gas City, Indiana for construction of a reconstructed Finish Line 2 with expanded production capacity, addition of a new Finish Line 4 for application of UV curable coatings and upgrading the existing catalytic oxidizer capacity to control emissions from existing Finish Line 1 and reconstructed Finish Line 2. Upon completion of the modification American Woodmark will have four (4) finish lines. VOC Emissions for the source are limited to less than 250 tons per year.

Public notice of the interim significant source modification petition was published on January 25, 2002. The public comment period ended on February 8, 2002. Since there are no comments received during the public comment period, pursuant to 326 IAC 2-13-1(i), the interim significant source modification petition is in effect on February 11, 2002 and expires on the effective date of the final significant source modification permit. The interim significant source modification petition may be revoked after this effective date upon a written finding by the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) that any of the reasons for denial in 326 IAC 2-13-1(h) exist or if the final significant source modification permit is denied. The IDEM has reviewed this interim significant source modification petition and has not found any such reason. The facilities specified in the interim significant source modification petition may not operate until the final significant source modification permit is issued by OAM.

The interim significant source modification petition is federally enforceable. Detailed construction and operation conditions will be specified in the final significant source modification permit 053-15248-00058.
