Dear David Sulc:

Nucor Steel was issued a permit on January 13, 1997 for hot mill rolling operation. A letter notifying the Office of Air Quality of change in the storage tank for rolling oil was received on January 15, 2002. This modification changes the descriptive information in this registration and does not affect emissions from this emission unit. The permit is hereby revised as follows (the language deleted is shown in strikethrough and added is shown in bold):

- (a) Additional rolling oil will be added to the hot mill rolling operation, the application rate is one pound of oil per ton of steel, maximum throughput is 502 tons per hour of steel. The rolling oil will be stored in a ~~400-gallon tote bin~~ **container or containers**.

All other conditions of the permit shall remain unchanged and in effect. Please attach a copy of this letter to the front of the original permit.
