Permit by Rule

Dear Mr. Madru:

Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-11-3, Kokomo Grain Company has been operating under a Permit By Rule for a grain elevator. A letter requesting the addition of a building to store grain was received on April 30, 2002. The source will still be able to operate under a Permit By Rule with the addition of this building. Since this source has been and will continue to operate under the provisions of 326 IAC 2-11-3, CP 081-8678-00008, issued in 1998, is voided. The Permit By Rule is hereby re-issued as follows to add the proposed storage building to the description of the source:

One (1) grain storage building, used to store corn or soybeans, equipped with two (2) 20,000 bushel per hour enclosed conveyors, capacity: 2,000,000 bushels of corn or soybeans.

All other conditions of the Permit By Rule shall remain unchanged and in effect. The source qualifies for a Permit By Rule because:

- (a) The source receives grain by truck or rail and ships grain by truck or rail.
- (b) For truck or rail grain receiving and truck or rail grain shipping, annual throughput limits are less than eleven million two hundred thousand (11,200,000) bushels.
