Dear Mr. Rice:

The letter from Mayfield Corporation, received on February 13, 2002, has been reviewed. This letter related to the plant located at 9400 West U. S. Highway 30, Wanatah, Indiana 46390. This letter requested that Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit (FESOP) 091-5642-00085 be revoked. The reason for this revocation request is that Mayfield Corporation determined that the source qualifies for a Permit-By-Rule (PBR) based on the actual emissions records of regulated air pollutants.

Pursuant to rule 326 IAC 2-1.1-9, any permit to construct or operate or any permit revision approval granted by the commissioner may be revoked for any other cause that establishes in the judgement of the commissioner the fact that continuance of the permit or permit revision approval is not consistent with the purposes of this article. Since Mayfield Corporation qualifies for a Permit-By-Rule, the FESOP will be revoked.
