Dear Mr. Rice:

The letter from W. Kendall and Sons, Inc., received on February 19, 2002, has been reviewed. This letter related to the plant located at 106 East 1st Street and 10270 West U.S. 30, Wanatah, Indiana 46390. This letter requested that Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit (FESOP) 091-5643-00112 be revoked. The reason for this revocation request is that W. Kendall and Sons, Inc. determined that the source qualifies for a Permit-By-Rule (PBR) based on the actual emissions records of regulated air pollutants.

Pursuant to rule 326 IAC 2-1.1-9, any permit to construct or operate or any permit revision approval granted by the commissioner may be revoked for any other cause that establishes in the judgement of the commissioner the fact that continuance of the permit or permit revision approval is not consistent with the purposes of this article. Since W. Kendall and Sons, Inc. qualifies for a Permit-By-Rule, the FESOP will be revoked.
