Dear Ms. Ronald:

The letter from Meshberger Brothers Stone Corporation, received on June 5, 2002, has been reviewed. This letter related to the plant located at 1972 West State Road 28, Ridgeville, Indiana 47380. This letter requested that Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit (FESOP) No. 135-5599-03158 be revoked. The reason for this revocation request is that the asphalt plant located at this site has been dismantled and replaced with a new plant. The new plant has been issued a FESOP on January 24, 2002 (FESOP No. 135-14643-03158).

Pursuant to rule 326 IAC 2-1.1-9, any permit to construct or operate or any permit revision approval granted by the commissioner may be revoked for any other cause that establishes in the judgement of the commissioner the fact that continuance of the permit or permit revision approval is not consistent with the purposes of this article. Since the asphalt plant permitted under FESOP No. 135-5599-03158 is no longer in operation, the FESOP will be revoked.
