Dear Mr. Grimmer:

On July 1, 2002, Hahn Equipment Company, A Subsidiary of the Toro Company, notified the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) that the facility located at 1625 North Garvin Street, Evansville, Indiana 47711, had permanently closed as of June 30, 2002, thus eliminating the need for an operating permit.

The Part 70 Operating Permit 163-7624-00007, issued on July 13, 1999, is hereby revoked. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-5(a) and (b), this revocation letter is effective in eighteen (18) days from the date of this letter.

Any construction or modification that would result in potential to emit greater than the exemption levels, as specified in 326 IAC 2-1.1-3 (Exemptions) shall be subject to New Source Review (NSR) and must be approved by the OAQ before such construction or modification may occur.
