Dear Mr. Voll:

On July 15, 2002, Sibley Machine and Foundry notified the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) that the equipment that the company originally obtained a permit for has been dismantled and is no longer in use, thus eliminating the need for the above referenced FESOP permit.

The Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit (FESOP) F141-5340-00039, issued on December 12, 1996, is hereby revoked. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-5(a) and (b), this revocation letter is effective in eighteen (18) days from the date of this letter.

Any construction or modification that would result in potential to emit greater than the exemption levels, as specified in 326 IAC 2-1.1-3 (Exemptions) shall be subject to New Source Review (NSR) and must be approved by the OAQ before such construction or modification may occur.
