Dear Mr. Gill:

A letter from Foamex, L.P., was received on March 18, 2003, requesting the revocation of Part 70 Permit T039-7431-00302, issued on April 20, 1999. Foamex, L.P., has requested that the Part 70 associated with the flexible polyurethane foam manufacturing plant (T039-7431-00302) be revoked due to ceasing production of foam products at 603 Industrial Parkway, Elkhart, Indiana. The building will now be used strictly for warehousing foam produced at other Foamex locations.

Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-1.1-9, any permit to construct or operate or any permit revision approval granted by the Commissioner may be revoked if there are changes in regulatory requirements that mandate either a temporary or permanent reduction of discharge of contaminants.

Since the Permittee has ceased foam production operations, Part 70 T039-7431-00302 and First Reopening 039-13234-00302 are revoked. The Office of Air Quality (OAQ) acknowledges that the plant will now be utilized for warehousing only.
