Dear David Boggs:

On April 11, 2003, a letter was submitted to the Office of Air Quality (OAQ). The letter stated that the company intended on building a new stack for the emissions from the Nebraska boiler. A modeling analysis was performed and submitted with this request. The question is whether this new stack can be built and whether any permit changes need to be made.

Jeffrey Stoakes of the Technical Support and Modeling section reviewed the modeling analysis performed for GE. He agreed with the numbers in the modeling. There is no increase in potential emissions. The maximum concentrations are below the NOx significant impact levels.

GE is not asking to change any emission limitations, or any monitoring, recordkeeping, or reporting requirements. The difference in the stack for the boiler will be reflected in the Title V permit when issued. There are no necessary permit changes to account for this stack change.
