Re: Response to Review Request No. 097-19039-00527 Permit Status Evaluation

Dear Mr. Dale:

Elliott Company of Indianapolis, located at 9200 Zionsville Road, Indianapolis, Indiana 46268, submitted a review request on March 26, 2004. The letter was submitted to determine if Elliott Company of Indianapolis requires an air pollution permit for a continuous rigid foam block manufacturing process.

Criteria pollutant threshold levels for exemptions are as follows:

**PM10** = <5tpy; **SO2** = <10 tpy; **NOx** = <10 tpy; **VOC** <10 tpy for sources not required to use air pollution control devices to comply with 328 IAC 8; **VOC** <5 tpy for sources required to use air pollution control devices to comply with 326 IAC 8; **CO** = < 25 tpy.

Based on the information provided in the review request, including the operational capacity of the source, the potential to emit of VOCs is less than ten (10) tons per year, and the source does not require an air pollution permit. If a source can comply with exempt levels, the burden of proof lies with the source. If the source requires a definite decision to be made by the IDEM, OAQ (Indiana Department of Environmental Management, Office of Air Quality) and OES (Office of Environmental Services) and a permit be issued, filing fees and any other permit fees shall be applicable according to the level of permit required.
