## Notice of Decision - Approval

Please be advised that on behalf of the Anderson Office of Air Management, I have issued a decision regarding the enclosed matter. Pursuant to 326 IAC 2, this approval was effective immediately upon submittal of the application.

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-37 requires that you file a petition for administrative review. This petition may include a request for stay of effectiveness and must be submitted to the Anderson Office of Air Management, P.O. Box 2100, Anderson, IN 46018, **within eighteen (18) calendar days form the mailing of this notice.** The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing:

- (1) the date the document is delivered to the Anderson Office of Air Management (AOAM);
- (2) the date of the post mark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to AOAM by U.S. mail; or
- (3) the date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the AOAM by private carrier.

The petition must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision or otherwise entitled to review by law. Please identify the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, date of this notice, and all of the following:

- (1) the name and address of the person making the request;
- (2) the interest of the person making the request;
- (3) identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (4) the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- (5) the issues, with particularity, proposed for considerations at any hearing; and
- (6) identification of the terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing documents.

Dear Mrs. Fields:

Your application for change of name and ownership from Church Brothers Collision Repair Inc. to Collision Cure, Inc. was received on January 16<sup>th</sup>, 2003 and has been reviewed. Based on the data submitted and the provisions in Section 1 of 326 IAC 2-1, it has been determined that your emission source, an automobile refinishing operation located at 1301 East 60<sup>th</sup> Street Anderson, IN, has met the criteria required to obtain a Source Specific Operating Agreement.

Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-5(a) and (b), approval of this Source Specific Operating Agreement shall not be effective until fifteen (15) days from the date of this letter.

The facilities and processes of this source are hereby granted the Source Specific Operating Agreement provided that the following requirements of 326 IAC 2-9 are satisfied:

**Section A: Automobile Refinishing Operation: [326 IAC 2-9-11]**

1. The total amount of volatile organic compounds (VOC) delivered to the automobile refinishing operation, less the amount of VOC that is quantified by manifest as having been shipped off-site, shall not exceed one (1) ton per month.
2. Particulate matter emissions shall be controlled by a dry filter system or an equivalent control device. The source shall operate the particulate control device at all times the automobile refinishing operation is in operation in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications. A source shall be considered in compliance with this requirement provided the overspray is not visibly detectable at the exhaust or accumulated on the rooftops or on the ground.
3. The source shall keep the following records from the automobile refinishing operation:
  - (a) purchase orders and invoices for each solvent containing material,
  - (b) the number of gallons of each solvent containing material used,
  - (c) the VOC content (pounds per gallon, as applied) of each solvent containing material used,
  - (d) the amount of waste VOC manifested off-site, and
  - (e) a summation on a monthly basis of emissions of VOC.

These records shall be kept for a minimum period of five (5) years, and made available upon request of the Anderson Office of Air Management (AOAM) and the Indiana Office of Air Quality (OAQ).

**Section B: General Requirements: [326 IAC 2-9-1]**

1. The source shall provide an annual notice to the Director of the Anderson Office of Air Management (AOAM) and the commissioner of OAQ, stating that the source is in operation, and certifying that its operations are in compliance with the requirements of this Source Specific Operating Agreement. The above annual notice shall be submitted to:

no later than January 30 of each year, with the annual notice being submitted in the format attached.

2. Any exceedance of any requirement contained in this operating agreement shall be reported, in writing, within one (1) week of its occurrence. Said report shall include information on the actions taken to correct the exceedance, including measures to reduce emissions, in order to comply with the established limits. If an exceedance is the result of a malfunction, then the provisions of 326 IAC 1-6 apply.
3. Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-9-1(i), the owner or operator is hereby notified that this operating agreement does not relieve the permittee of the responsibility to comply with the provisions of any applicable federal, state, or local rules, or any New Source Performance Standards (NSPS), 40 CFR Part 60, or National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP), 40 CFR Part 61.

Any change or modification which will alter operations in such a way that it will no longer comply with the applicable restrictions and conditions of this operating agreement, must obtain the appropriate approval from the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) and/or Anderson Office of Air Management (AOAM) under 326 IAC 2-1, 326 IAC 2-2, 326 IAC 2-3, 326 IAC 2-7, and 326 IAC 2-8, before such change may occur.
