Dear Mr. Willoughby:

Inland Paperboard and Packaging, Inc. was issued a Registration permit on November 15, 2002 pertaining to the operation of a paperboard and packaging facility. An application was received May 20, 2004 requesting that the emission statement condition be removed from the permit due to the revisions to 326 IAC 2-6 (Emission Reporting) which became effective on March 27, 2004. The Permittee is no longer required to submit an annual emission statement and it has been removed from the permit, and is hereby amended as follows:

~~1. Pursuant to (326 IAC 2-6): the Permittee shall submit an annual emission statement certified pursuant to the requirements of 326 IAC 2-6, that must be received by April 15 of each year and must comply with the minimum requirements specified in 326 IAC 2-6-4. The annual emission statement shall meet the following requirements:~~

~~(a) Indicate actual emissions of criteria pollutants from the source, in compliance with 326 IAC 2-6 (Emission Reporting); The annual emission statement covers the twelve (12) consecutive month time period starting December 1 and ending November 30. The annual emission statement must be submitted to:~~

~~The annual emission statement required by this permit shall be considered timely if the date postmarked on the envelope or certified mail receipt, or affixed by the shipper on the private shipping receipt, is on or before the date it is due. If the document is submitted by any other means, it shall be considered timely if received by IDEM, OAQ, and the EEPA on or before the date it is due. The submittal by the Permittee does require the certification by the "authorized individual" as defined by 326 IAC 2-1.1-1~~

All other conditions of the permit shall remain unchanged and in effect. Please attach a copy of this amendment and the following revised permit page to the front of the original permit.
