Notice of Decision – Approval

Please be advised that on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Management, I have issued a decision regarding the enclosed matter. Pursuant to 326 IAC 2, this approval was effective immediately upon submittal of the application.

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-3-7 requires that you file a petition for administrative review. This petition may include a request for stay of effectiveness and must be submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication, 100 North Senate Avenue, Government Center North, Room 1049, Indianapolis, IN 46204, **within eighteen (18) calendar days from the mailing of this notice**. The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing:

- (1) the date the document is delivered to the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA);
- (2) the date of the postmark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to OEA by U.S. mail; or
- (3) The date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the OEA by private carrier.

The petition must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision or otherwise entitled to review by law. Please identify the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, date of this notice and all of the following:

- (1) the name and address of the person making the request;
- (2) the interest of the person making the request;
- (3) identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (4) the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- (5) the issues, with particularity, proposed for considerations at any hearing; and
- (6) identification of the terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing documents of the type issued by the Commissioner.

A.2 Emission Units and Pollution Control Equipment Summary [326 IAC 2-8-3(c)(3)]

This stationary source consists of the following emission units and pollution control devices:

- (a) Three (3) surface coating booths, known as E1, E2 and E3, each equipped with high volume low pressure spray applicators (HVLP) and dry filters for overspray control, exhausted through Stacks E1, E2 and E3, installed in 1995, capacity: 4.5 plastic vehicle parts per hour, each.
- (b) One (1) surface coating booth, known as E4, equipped with high volume low pressure spray applicators (HVLP) and dry filters for overspray control, exhausted through Stack E4, to be installed in 2000, capacity: 20 metal panels per hour.

A.3 Insignificant Activities [326 IAC 2-7-1(21)] [326 IAC 2-8-3(c)(3)(I)]

This stationary source also includes the following insignificant activities, as defined in 326 IAC 2-7-1(21):

- (a) Natural gas-fired combustion sources with heat input equal to or less than ten million (10,000,000) British thermal units per hour consisting of:
 - (1) One (1) natural gas-fired air make-up unit, known as H1, installed in 1995, exhausted inside the building, rated at 2.5 million British thermal units per hour (deemed an insignificant activity).
 - (2) Two (2) natural gas-fired radiant heaters, known as H2 and H3, installed in 1997, exhausted through Stacks H2 and H3, rated at 0.150 million British thermal units per hour each.
 - (3) Two (2) natural gas-fired space heaters, known as H6 and H7, rated at 0.160 and 0.200 million British thermal units per hour, respectively, to be installed in 2000.
