Dear Mr. Walker:

On May 13, 2004, the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) received a Review Request to add three (3) hoppers and two (2) conveyors, with a capacity of 400 tons of limestone, total, to your existing source, located at 1100 Quarry Road NW, Corydon, Indiana 47112. Corydon Stone & Asphalt, Inc. was issued a Source Specific Operating Agreement (SSOA) (S 061-16894-00006) under Option 3 of 326 IAC 2-9-8 on June 4, 2003.

Prior to June 4, 2003, Corydon Stone & Asphalt, Inc. operated under T 061-7523-00006, issued on April 15, 1999, First Administrative Amendment AAT 061-11193-00006, issued October 6, 1999, First Reopening R 061-13307-00006, issued January 4, 2002, Second Administrative Amendment AAT 061-17237-00006, issued on March 17, 2003, and Third Administrative Amendment AAT 061-17281-00006, issued on March 25, 2003. As a result of those approvals, your source had already complied with the construction permit requirements that are necessary for a source to obtain a SSOA under Option 3 of 326 IAC 2-9-8 when the application to S 061-16894-00006 was received on March 6, 2003.

Pursuant to Condition 1 in Section A of S 061-16894-00006, issued on June 4, 2003, Corydon Stone & Asphalt, Inc. is permitted to operate as many as nine (9) crushers, seventeen (17) screens, and one (1) conveying operation. Corydon Stone & Asphalt, Inc. does not need to obtain an administrative amendment to S 061-16894-00006 for any change or modification as long as Corydon Stone & Asphalt, Inc. continues to comply with the requirements of 326 IAC 2-9-8(b)(3). However, any change or modification that could cause Corydon Stone & Asphalt, Inc. to no longer comply with requirements of 326 IAC 2-9-8(b)(3) does require prior IDEM, OAQ approval.
