Notice of Decision: Approval - Effective Immediately

Please be advised that on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Management, I have issued a decision regarding the enclosed matter. Pursuant to IC 13-15-5-3, this permit is effective immediately, unless a petition for stay of effectiveness is filed and granted according to IC 13-15-6-3, and may be revoked or modified in accordance with the provisions of IC 13-15-7-1.

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-3 and IC 13-15-6-1 require that you file a petition for administrative review. This petition may include a request for stay of effectiveness and must be submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication, 100 North Senate Avenue, Government Center North, Room 1049, Indianapolis, IN 46204, **within eighteen (18) calendar days of the mailing of this notice**. The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing:

- (1) the date the document is delivered to the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA);
- (2) the date of the postmark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to OEA by U.S. mail; or
- (3) The date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the OEA by private carrier.

The petition must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision or otherwise entitled to review by law. Please identify the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, date of this notice and all of the following:

- (1) the name and address of the person making the request;
- (2) the interest of the person making the request;
- (3) identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (4) the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- (5) the issues, with particularity, proposed for considerations at any hearing; and
- (6) identification of the terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing documents of the type issued by the Commissioner.

Vulcan Materials Company was issued a Source Specific Operation Agreement S157-7494-00079 on December 27, 1996 for operation of a sand and gravel plant located at 1501 East 510 South, Lafayette, Indiana 47905. On August 19, 2004 Vulcan Materials Company submitted a notice to modify their facility to make it more efficient.

The planned modifications consist of replacing the current plant's secondary cone crusher, scalping screen and conveyors (that feed both the crusher and the scalping screen), as well as adding an additional 30 inch conveyor to the North pit to extend the system an additional 50 feet.

The new pieces of equipment that will replace the above equipment include; a Remco VSI crusher, a 5x 16 Svedala triple deck scalping screen, a 30 inch feed conveyor, a 30 inch crusher return conveyor and a 24 inch oversize conveyor.

The addition of this equipment will not increase the plant throughput. These changes will keep the plant within the operating restrictions of twelve crushers, twenty-four screens, one conveying system and 3,100,000 tons per year of annual throughput.

This source shall comply with 40CFR60 Subpart OOO, Standards of Performance for Nonmetallic Mineral Processing Plants, if applicable. Any testing required by 40 CFR60, Subpart OOO shall be performed within 180 days of start up.

Based on the above information, the Vulcan Materials Company complies with the requirements of 326 IAC 2-9-7, therefore no additional permitting approval is necessary for the described construction project and the Source Specific Operating Agreement S157-7494-00079 remains unchanged and in effect.

Any change or modification which will alter operations in such a way that it will no longer comply with the applicable restrictions and conditions of this operating agreement, must obtain the appropriate approval from the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) under 326 IAC 2-5.1, 326 IAC 2-5.5, 326 IAC 2-6.1, 326 IAC 2-2, 326 IAC 2-3, 326 IAC 2-7, and 326 IAC 2-8, before such change may occur.
