Dear Mr. Rader:

The application from Pfizer, Inc., received on January 20, 2005, has been reviewed. Based on the data submitted and the provisions in 326 IAC 2-5.5, it has been determined that the following stationary batch pharmaceutical manufacturing operation, to be located at 100 Pfizer Drive, Terre Haute, Indiana, is classified as registered:

- (a) One (1) pharmaceutical manufacturing operation, identified as Bldg 1247, for sterile products. This facility includes process tanks and vessels, sterilization filters, a crystallizer, a centrifuge, product dryers, mills and packaging equipment. Emissions exhaust to stacks 3 and 4. Bldg 1247 was constructed in 1981.
- (b) Other activities or categories not previously identified: Pharmaceutical production processes in Buildings 1238, 1243, 1244, 1247 and 1250, including all storage tanks associated with the listed buildings.

The following conditions shall be applicable:

Pfizer Inc is located outside of the coordinates that limits the opacity to thirty percent (30%). Therefore pursuant to 326 IAC 5-1-2 (Opacity Limitations), except as provided in 326 IAC 5-1-3 (Temporary Exemptions), opacity shall meet the following:

- (a) Opacity shall not exceed an average of forty percent (40%) in any one (1) six (6) minute averaging period as determined in 326 IAC 5-1-4.
- (b) Opacity shall not exceed sixty percent (60%) for more than a cumulative total of 15 minutes (60 readings) in a 6-hour period as measured according to 40 CFR 60, Appendix A, Method 9 or fifteen (15) one (1) minute non-overlapping integrated averages for a continuous opacity monitor in a six (6) hour period.

Pfizer, Inc. was issued a Title V Operating Permit on June 28, 2004. The January 20, 2005 application transfers the majority of emission units to Danisco Sweeteners (167-20471-00138, effective 12:01 AM July 1, 2005). Pfizer's remaining emission units qualify the source as a Registration. Therefore the source may operate according to 326 IAC 2-5.5.

Any change or modification which may increase the potential to emit a combination of HAPs or VOC to twenty-five (25) tons per year or a single HAP to ten (10) tons per year from this source shall require approval from IDEM, OAQ prior to making the change.

An authorized individual shall provide an annual notice to the Vigo County Air Pollution Control Office that the source is in operation and in compliance with this registration pursuant to 326 IAC 2-5.5-4(a)(3). The annual notice shall be submitted to:

no later than January 31 of each year, with the annual notice being submitted in the format attached.

An application or notification shall be submitted in accordance with 326 IAC 2 to the Vigo County Air Pollution Control Office if the source proposes to construct new emission units, modify existing emission units, or otherwise modify the source.
