Notice of Decision – Approval

Please be advised that on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Management, I have issued a decision regarding the enclosed matter. Pursuant to 326 IAC 2, this approval was effective immediately upon submittal of the application.

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-3-7 requires that you file a petition for administrative review. This petition may include a request for stay of effectiveness and must be submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication, 100 North Senate Avenue, Government Center North, Room 1049, Indianapolis, IN 46204, **within eighteen (18) calendar days from the mailing of this notice**. The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing:

- (1) the date the document is delivered to the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA);
- (2) the date of the postmark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to OEA by U.S. mail; or
- (3) The date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the OEA by private carrier.

The petition must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision or otherwise entitled to review by law. Please identify the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, date of this notice and all of the following:

- (1) the name and address of the person making the request;
- (2) the interest of the person making the request;
- (3) identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (4) the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- (5) the issues, with particularity, proposed for considerations at any hearing; and
- (6) identification of the terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing documents of the type issued by the Commissioner.

Dear Mr. Slavens:

Federal Mogul Corporation, located at 101 industrial Boulevard, Logansport, Indiana 46947 was issued a FESOP on February 23, 2000 for the operation of a stationary source that manufactures fuel pumps and auto light lenses used in the automobile industry. A letter requesting the installation of the following insignificant emission unit was received on July 13, 2004, which qualifies as an administrative amendment under 326 IAC 2-8-10:

- (a) One (1) pump test stand, which consists of one (1) diesel pump tester, identified as JDAutTst with a maximum capacity of 60 pumps per day, vented through stack #27. This unit has a PTE of 0.01 tons of VOC per year and is functionally the same way as the existing GEROTST test stand listed under the Insignificant Activities of the TV TSD.

The existing permitted test pumps similar to this proposed test pump were listed in the TSD but were not listed in the issued FESOP. Therefore, it is not necessary to amend the FESOP.

All conditions of the permit shall remain unchanged and in effect. Please attach a copy of this amendment and the following revised permit pages to the front of the original permit.
