Dear Mr. Bourque:

Jeffboat L.L.C., located at 1030 E. Market Street, Jeffersonville, Indiana 47130-4330, submitted a review request on October 21, 2004. The letter was submitted to notify the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) of additional flame cutting and steel plate welding equipment to be constructed and operated at the source. The source stated that it would continue to operate at a manufacturing capacity of 600 barges per year, with no increase in the potential to emit regulated criteria pollutants or hazardous air pollutants.

The OAQ has determined that construction and operation of this additional flame cutting and steel plate welding equipment will not require modification of the existing Part 70 Operating Permit T019-6874-00006, since the potential to emit of regulated criteria pollutants and hazardous air pollutants permit from both the flame cutting and welding operations were originally calculated assuming a maximum capacity of 600 barges per year. The descriptions of welding in Section D.4 and flame cutting in Section D.5 are not based upon an amount of equipment. Therefore, no change is necessary to the permit for these additions. The source will continue to operate subject to the conditions contained in the existing Part 70 Operating Permit T019-6874-00006.
