Dear Mr. Ridge:

The letter from Cargill, Inc., received on November 4, 2004, has been reviewed. This letter requested that SSOA No. 163-19455-00039, issued for a stationary grain handling operation located 2000 W. Ohio Street, Evansville, IN 47712, be revoked. The reason for the revocation request is the facility cannot operate under the current SSOA because the current permit requires a mineral oil application rate that conflicts with United States FDA mineral oil application rate requirements. Please be advised that IDEM is reviewing the regulatory options to address this conflict. Cargill has requested to revert to its former Permit By Rule 163-15483-00039. The facility continues to meet requirements pursuant to 326 IAC 2-10.

Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-1.1-9, any permit to construct or operate or any permit revision approval granted by the commissioner may be revoked for any cause that establishes in the judgment of the commissioner the fact that continuance of the permit or permit revision approval is not consistent with the purposes of 326 IAC 2. By means of a contractual agreement, Article 2.f, with the Indiana Department of Environmental Management, the Evansville Environmental Protection Agency is authorized to "process, review, issue, amend, revise, revoke, or deny permits" such as exemptions (for companies requesting them), registrations, Source Specific Operating Agreements, Minor Source Operating Permits, general permits, and requests for determinations under Permit by Rule."

Therefore, the Source Specific Operating Permit 163-19455-00039, issued on September 23, 2004, is hereby revoked. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-5(a) and (b), this revocation letter is effective in eighteen (18) days from the date of this letter.

In addition, the Permit By Rule determination #163-15483-00039 is hereby reinstated. Please keep this letter for your records. Please contact Alma Mifflin, Permitting Specialist if you require a new copy of the Permit By Rule determination or if you have any questions regarding the SSOA revocation.
