Notice of Decision – Approval

Please be advised that on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Management, I have issued a decision regarding the enclosed matter. Pursuant to 326 IAC 2, this approval was effective immediately upon submittal of the application.

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-3-7 requires that you file a petition for administrative review. This petition may include a request for stay of effectiveness and must be submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication, 100 North Senate Avenue, Government Center North, Room 1049, Indianapolis, IN 46204, **within eighteen (18) calendar days from the mailing of this notice**. The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing:

- (1) the date the document is delivered to the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA);
- (2) the date of the postmark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to OEA by U.S. mail; or
- (3) The date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the OEA by private carrier.

The petition must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision or otherwise entitled to review by law. Please identify the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, date of this notice and all of the following:

- (1) the name and address of the person making the request;
- (2) the interest of the person making the request;
- (3) identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (4) the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- (5) the issues, with particularity, proposed for considerations at any hearing; and
- (6) identification of the terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing documents of the type issued by the Commissioner.

Dear Mr. Chermak:

Midwest Pipe Coating, Inc., located at 925 Kennedy Avenue, Scherverville, Indiana 46375 was issued a FESOP on August 29, 2002 for a stationary metal pipe and bar abrasive cleaning and coating operation. A letter requesting a change was received on December 29, 2004. The change involves the following:

- (a) Replacement of an existing Dusthog dust collector, unit CE7, exhausting at stack S/V17 with a new unit that is comparable in size, same air flow rate and will use a reverse pulse jet design for continuous cleaning, except the new unit will have its filter cartridges mounted vertically to provide better cleaning and maintenance. The existing Dusthog has its filter cartridges mounted horizontally which promotes premature gasket wear and overloading of the top surfaces of the cartridges. During winter months exhaust air will be rerouted inside the building.

The above change qualifies as an administrative amendment, pursuant to 326 IAC 2-8-10. No amendment is necessary to the replaced facility description in Section A.2(c) of the FESOP.

Existing conditions for this replaced facility, as well as all other conditions of the permit shall remain unchanged and in effect. Please attach a copy of this amendment to the front of the original permit.
