Dear Mr. Young:

ChemCentral, located at 5850 West 82nd Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46267, submitted a review request on April 19, 2004. The letter was submitted to determine if ChemCentral requires additional air pollution permitting as a result of 40 CFR 63, National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) for Organic Liquid Distribution (Non Gasoline).

This NESHAP applies to new and existing organic liquids distribution (OLD) (non-gasoline) operations, which are carried out at storage terminals, refineries, crude oil pipeline stations, and various manufacturing facilities. This NESHAP implements section 112(d) of the Clean Air Act (CAA) by requiring all OLD operations at plant sites that are major sources of HAPs to meet hazardous air pollutant (HAP) emissions standards reflecting the application of the maximum achievable control technology (MACT). A major source of HAPs as defined in 40 CFR 63 is any source that has the potential to emit 10 tons per year or more of any HAP or 25 tons per year or more of any combination of HAPs. Based on the information provided in the request for review, ChemCentral is not a major source of HAPs. The requirements for the NESHAP for OLD would not be applicable to ChemCentral.

If the source requires a decision to be made by the IDEM, OAQ (Indiana Department of Environmental Management, Office of Air Quality) and OES (Office of Environmental Services) and a permit be issued or modified, filing fees and any other permit fees shall be applicable according to the level of permit required.
