Dear Mr. Dupaquier:

The Indiana Army Ammunition Plant (INAAP) submitted a review request on April 15, 2004, to assess whether an air pollution permit is required for their operation and requested confirmation that an emission statement does not need to be filed due to the revisions to 326 IAC 2-6 (Emission Reporting) which became effective on March 27, 2004.

A letter was received November 26, 1996, withdrawing the draft FESOP application (019-6178-00009) and enclosed a transition application. The letter indicated that INAAP intended to submit a SSOA application. The most recent correspondence does not contain enough information to determine whether a permit is needed. The source does not have an operating permit so there is not a condition to amend for the emission reporting.

Any construction or modification that would result in potential to emit greater than the exemption levels, as specified in 326 IAC 2-1.1-3 (Exemptions) shall be subject to New Source Review (NSR) and must be approved by the OAQ before such construction or modification may occur.
