Dear Mr. Stephenson:

Goldshield of Indiana, Inc., located at 2004 Patterson Street, Decatur, Indiana 46733, submitted a review request on September 30, 2004. The letter was submitted to notify the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) of operational changes to one of the chopper guns of the existing lamination and gel coat spray booth, identified as PC2 in Building 43-1. The source will now operate the chopper gun robotically instead of manually, with no increase in the potential to emit regulated criteria pollutants or hazardous air pollutants. In addition, the source has requested the ability to change spray application from manual to robotic (or robotic to manual), as needed, in all the lamination, gel, and chop booths at the source.

The OAQ has determined that these operational changes will not require modification of the existing Part 70 Operating Permit T001-6067-00043, since the permit, as currently written, does not limit the operations to manual or robotic. In addition, the source is not required to obtain pre-construction approval for these operational changes. The source will continue to operate subject to the conditions contained in the existing Part 70 Operating Permit T001-6067-00043.
