Notice of Decision – Approval

Please be advised that on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Management, I have issued a decision regarding the enclosed matter. Pursuant to 326 IAC 2, this approval was effective immediately upon submittal of the application.

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-3-7 requires that you file a petition for administrative review. This petition may include a request for stay of effectiveness and must be submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication, 100 North Senate Avenue, Government Center North, Room 1049, Indianapolis, IN 46204, **within eighteen (18) calendar days from the mailing of this notice**. The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing:

- (1) the date the document is delivered to the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA);
- (2) the date of the postmark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to OEA by U.S. mail; or
- (3) The date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the OEA by private carrier.

The petition must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision or otherwise entitled to review by law. Please identify the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, date of this notice and all of the following:

- (1) the name and address of the person making the request;
- (2) the interest of the person making the request;
- (3) identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (4) the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- (5) the issues, with particularity, proposed for considerations at any hearing; and
- (6) identification of the terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing documents of the type issued by the Commissioner.

Heartland Recreational Vehicles, LLC was issued a Registration on April 13, 2004 for a stationary recreational vehicle production source. An application was received May 3, 2004, requesting that the emission statement condition be removed from the permit due to the revisions to 326 IAC 2-6 (emission Reporting) which became effective on March 27, 2004. The Permittee is no longer required to submit an emission statement; therefore, the emission statement condition will be removed from the permit. Pursuant to the provisions of 326 IAC 2-5.5-6(d) the permit is hereby administratively amended as follows:

Condition 2 has been removed and the remaining conditions renumbered:

~~(2) Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-6 (Emission Statement)~~

~~(a) The Permittee shall submit an annual emission statement certified pursuant to the requirements of 326 IAC 2-6, that must be received by April 15 of each year and must comply with the minimum requirements specified in 326 IAC 2-6-4. The annual emission statement shall meet the following requirements:~~

~~(1) Indicate estimated actual emissions of criteria pollutants from the source, in compliance with 326 IAC 2-6 (Emission Reporting);~~

~~(b) The annual emission statement covers the twelve (12) consecutive month time period starting December 1 and ending November 30. The annual emission statement must be submitted to:~~

~~(c) The annual emission statement required by this permit shall be considered timely if the date postmarked on the envelope or certified mail receipt, or affixed by the shipper on the private shipping receipt, is on or before the date it is due. If the document submitted by any other means, it shall be considered timely if received by IDEM, OAQ on or before the date it is due.~~

~~The submittal by the Permittee does require the certification by the "authorized individual" as defined by 326 IAC 2-1.1-1.~~

All other conditions of the permit shall remain unchanged and in effect. Please attach a copy of this letter and the following revised permit pages to the front of the original permit.

Dear Mr. Rhymer:

An application requesting that the emission statement reporting requirement be removed from the permit due to the revisions of 326 IAC 2-6 (Emission Reporting) was received May 3, 2004. The following is a revision of the registration removing Condition No. 2 and renumbering the remaining conditions:

The application from Heartland Recreational Vehicles, LLC, received on February 20, 2004, has been reviewed. Based on the data submitted and the provisions in 326 IAC 2-5.1, it has been determined that the following emission units, to be located at 28868 Paul Drive, Elkhart, Indiana, are classified as registered:

- (a) One (1) travel trailer fabrication and final finish process, designated as EU-01, producing 0.75 travel trailers per hour, exhausting inside the building, including the following: surface coating operations using hand held aerosol cans, manual application systems and caulk guns.
- (b) One (1) mill shop consisting of wood cutting equipment, identified as MS-01, exhausting inside the building, including three (3) chop saws, one (1) table saw, one (1) band saw, and one (1) drill press, equipped with a dust collection system, with a collection efficiency of 99.9%.
- (c) Twelve (12) natural gas-fired radiant tube heaters, identified as H-01 through H-12, each with maximum heat input rate of 0.1 mmBtu/hr.

The following conditions shall be applicable:

- (1) Pursuant to 326 IAC 5-1-2 (Opacity Limitations) except as provided in 326 IAC 5-1-3 (Temporary Alternative Opacity Limitations), opacity shall meet the following:
 - (a) Opacity shall not exceed an average of forty percent (40%) in any one (1) six (6) minute averaging period as determined in 326 IAC 5-1-4.
 - (b) Opacity shall not exceed sixty percent (60%) for more than a cumulative total of 15 minutes (60 readings) in a 6-hour period as measured according to 40 CFR 60, Appendix A, Method 9 or fifteen (15) one (1) minute nonoverlapping integrated averages for a continuous opacity monitor in a six (6) hour period.

- (2) Pursuant to 326 IAC 8-2-9 (Miscellaneous Metal Coating Operations), when coating metal parts, the volatile organic compound (VOC) content of the coating delivered to the applicator at the surface coating operations shall be limited to 3.5 pounds of VOCs per gallon of coating less water, for extreme performance coatings.

Solvent sprayed from application equipment during cleanup or color changes shall be directed into containers. Such containers shall be closed as soon as such solvent spraying is complete, and the waste solvent shall be disposed of in such a manner that evaporation is minimized.

Compliance with this rule for the metal parts surface coating operation(s) shall be shown by use of the following equation to calculate daily volume weighted average:

$$A = [\sum (C \times U) / \sum U]$$

Where: A is the volume weighted average in pounds VOC per gallon less water as applied;
C is the VOC content of the coating in pounds VOC per gallon less water as applied;
and U is the usage rate of the coating in gallons per day.

- (3) The particulate matter (PM) emissions from the woodworking operation at this facility shall be limited to 2.91 pounds per hour, calculated by the following:

Interpolation and extrapolation of the data for the process weight rate up to sixty thousand (60,000) pounds per hour shall be accomplished by use of the equation:

$$E = 4.10 P^{0.67} \quad \text{where } E = \text{rate of emission in pounds per hour and} \\ P = \text{process weight rate in tons per hour}$$

- (4) Any change or modification which may increase the potential to emit of a single Hazardous Air Pollutant (HAP) to 10 tons per year or greater, or that of Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) or any combination of HAPs to 25 tons per year or greater, shall require prior approval of the Office of Air Quality (OAQ).

This registration is the first air approval issued to this source. The source may operate according to 326 IAC 2-5.5.

An authorized individual shall provide an annual notice to the Office of Air Quality that the source is in operation and in compliance with this registration pursuant to 326 IAC 2-5.1-2(f)(3). The annual notice shall be submitted to:

no later than March 1 of each year, with the annual notice being submitted in the format attached.

An application or notification shall be submitted in accordance with 326 IAC 2 to the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) if the source proposes to construct new emission units, modify existing emission units, or otherwise modify the source.
