Dear Mr. Zint:

The Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) sent outreach material on February 28, 2005, to all Part 70 permit holders stating that they may be subject to the National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for Industrial, Commercial, and Institutional Boilers and Process Heaters (Boiler NESHAP). Your request for clarification of the applicability of this NESHAP to your facility was received on April 20, 2005.

We have reviewed your renewal Part 70 permit T163-17594-00008, issued February 1, 2005, and have determined that 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart DDDDD, does not have any standards that apply at your facility. Presently, all combustion sources that fall under the process heater definition at your facility are classified as insignificant activities and belong in the existing, small, gaseous fuel subcategory of this NESHAP. This subcategory has no standards or requirements. If any boilers or process heaters are constructed in the future, the applicability of this NESHAP to your source is subject to change.
