Dear Mr. Valmassoi:

Master Spas, Inc., located at 6927 Lincoln Parkway, Fort Wayne, Indiana was issued a Part 70 permit on May 16, 2001 for a fiberglass reinforced plastic spa manufacturing plant. A Minor Source Modification 003-19919-00249; and Minor Permit Modification 003-19975-00249 were issued on February 1, 2005 and May 23, 2005 respectively, for the addition and operation of a third fiberglass chop booth/flow coater, known as S18. The application indicated that this flow coater was intended to apply the final layer of polyester resin after a first layer of polyester resin has been applied from another fiberglass chop booth/flow coater.

On June 10, 2005, a letter was submitted to operate the S18 fiberglass chop booth/flow coater for production flexibility, instead of what was set forth in the Minor Source Modification 003-19919-00249; and Minor Permit Modification 003-19975-00249. Each fiberglass unit will receive just one coat of polyester resin from either the second or third fiberglass chop booth/flow coater.

The requested change in the operation of the S18 fiberglass chop booth/flow coater will not result in production increase. Applicable requirements and decisions made in Minor Source Modification 003-19919-00249; and Minor Permit Modification 003-19975-00249 will remain the same.

IDEM, OAQ prefers not to change the TSD for the Minor Source Modification 003-19919-00249 and Minor Permit Modification 003-19975-0024 because the TSD preserves the original information from these previous permits. However, the change in the operation for this third fiberglass chop booth/flow coater is noted in this letter.

No sections in the Part 70 permit are affected by the change, therefore, all conditions of the permit shall remain unchanged and in effect. Please attach a copy of this letter to the front of the original permit.
