Notice of Decision – Approval

Please be advised that on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Management, I have issued a decision regarding the enclosed matter. Pursuant to 326 IAC 2, this approval was effective immediately upon submittal of the application.

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-3-7 requires that you file a petition for administrative review. This petition may include a request for stay of effectiveness and must be submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication, 100 North Senate Avenue, Government Center North, Room 1049, Indianapolis, IN 46204, **within eighteen (18) calendar days from the mailing of this notice**. The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing:

- (1) the date the document is delivered to the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA);
- (2) the date of the postmark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to OEA by U.S. mail; or
- (3) The date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the OEA by private carrier.

The petition must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision or otherwise entitled to review by law. Please identify the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, date of this notice and all of the following:

- (1) the name and address of the person making the request;
- (2) the interest of the person making the request;
- (3) identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (4) the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- (5) the issues, with particularity, proposed for considerations at any hearing; and
- (6) identification of the terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing documents of the type issued by the Commissioner.

The Flexaust Company, Inc. was issued a Registered Construction and Operation Status approval on December 18, 2002, for a flexible ductwork manufacturing operation. The following is a revision of the registration acknowledging the change in the Authorized Individual.

The application from The Flexaust Company, Inc., received on August 19, 2002, has been reviewed. Based on the data submitted and the provisions in 326 IAC 2-5.1 it has been determined that the following flexible ductwork manufacturing operation, located at 1510 Armstrong Road, Warsaw, Indiana, is classified as registered:

The source consists of the following emission units and pollution control devices:

- (a) Flexible ductwork adhesive assembly unit, identified as (ID 200), with a maximum capacity of 32.07 lbs/ hr of product, using no control equipment, and exhausting to stack ID 200.
- (b) Flexible ductwork adhesive assembly unit, identified as (ID 201), with a maximum capacity of 32.07 lbs/ hr of product, using no control equipment, and exhausting to stack ID 201.
- (c) Flexible ductwork adhesive assembly unit, identified as (ID 205), with a maximum capacity of 32.07 lbs/ hr of product, using no control equipment, and exhausting to stack ID 205.
- (d) Flexible ductwork adhesive assembly unit, identified as (ID 206), with a maximum capacity of 32.07 lbs/ hr of product, using no control equipment, and exhausting to stack ID 206.
- (e) Cuffing station, attachment of fabric or felt to ends of ductwork using adhesive, identified as (cuffing station), with a maximum capacity of 6.75 lbs/ hr of product, using no control equipment, and exhausting to general exhaust B.

The following conditions shall be applicable:



Pursuant to 326 IAC 5-1-2 (Opacity Limitations) except as provided in 326 IAC 5-1-3 (Temporary Alternative Opacity Limitations), opacity shall meet the following:

- (a) Opacity shall not exceed an average of forty percent (40%) in any one (1) six (6) minute averaging period as determined in 326 IAC 5-1-4.
- (b) Opacity shall not exceed sixty percent (60%) for more than a cumulative total of 15 minutes (60 readings) in a 6-hour period as measured according to 40 CFR 60, Appendix A, Method 9 or fifteen (15) one (1) minute non-overlapping integrated averages for a continuous opacity monitor in a six (6) hour period.

326 IAC 8-2-9(c) & (d)(2) (Miscellaneous metal coating operations)

Pursuant to 326 IAC 8-2-9 (Miscellaneous metal coating operations), no surface coating of miscellaneous metal parts and products may cause, allow, or permit the discharge into the atmosphere of any volatile organic compounds in excess of the following:

- (1) 3.5 pounds per gallon of coating excluding water, delivered to a coating applicator in a coating application system that is air dried or forced warm air dried at temperatures up to one hundred ninety-four degrees Fahrenheit.

326 IAC 8-1-2(a)(10)(A) (General Provisions relating to VOC rules: compliance methods)

In order to demonstrate compliance with the limits of 326 IAC 8-2-9, this source shall be subject to the requirements of 326 IAC 8-1-2(a)(10)(A).

This registration is the first air approval issued to this source. The source may operate according to 326 IAC 2-5.5.

An authorized individual shall provide an annual notice to the Office of Air Quality that the source is in operation and in compliance with this registration pursuant to 326 IAC 2-5.1-2(f)(3). The annual notice shall be submitted to:

no later than March 1 of each year, with the annual notice being submitted in the format attached.

An application or notification shall be submitted in accordance with 326 IAC 2 to the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) if the source proposes to construct new emission units, modify existing emission units, or otherwise modify the source.
