Toyota Tsusho America, Inc. was issued a Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit (FESOP) No. 005-20322-00094 on February 11, 2005 for a stationary cast iron chip drying source located at 5560 South 175 West, Columbus, Indiana, 47201. A letter notifying the Office of Air Quality (OAQ) of a change to the operations was received on February 22, 2006. The source plans to lower the operating temperature of the afterburner associated with the chip dryer from 1,400°F to 800°F. The OAQ has determined that this change in operation of the afterburner will not require modification of the existing FESOP No. 005-20322-00094, since the afterburner descriptions in Sections A.2 and D.1 of the permit do not specify the operating temperature and since the use of the afterburner is not required to comply with any applicable requirements or regulations. In addition, the source is not required to obtain pre-construction approval for this operational change. The source will continue to operate subject to the conditions contained in the existing FESOP No. 005-20322-00094.
