Dear Mr. Scherf:

ChromaSource, Inc. was issued a Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit (FESOP) on July 28, 2006 for the continued operation of a stationary coating and laminating paper color sample manufacturing source. The Office of Air Quality has determined that it is necessary to reopen the FESOP.

It is necessary to reopen the permit because comments that were made by ChromaSource, Inc. during the public notice period for Federally Enforceable State Operating Permit (FESOP) No.: F183-22555-00033 regarding the design set-up of the regenerative thermal oxidizers (RTO) were not adequately addressed in the Addendum to the Technical Support Document or in the FESOP. The RTO is used to control volatile organic compounds (VOC) and hazardous air pollutants (HAPs) emissions from three (3) coating lines and one (1) cleaning operation. Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-8-8(a)(2) and 326 IAC 2-8-8(a)(3), IDEM is reopening the FESOP permit to correct any permit conditions related to the RTO set-up so that ChromaSource, Inc. is able to comply with the requirements of the permit. Additionally, permit Condition C.7 (Asbestos Abatement Projects) will be revised during the permit reopening to remove the statement under paragraph (g) that indicates that the requirement to use an Indiana Accredited Asbestos inspector is not federally enforceable.

Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-8-8(c), the reopening and revision of a FESOP under 326 IAC 2-8-8(a) shall not be initiated before a notice of such intent is provided to a FESOP source by the commissioner at least thirty (30) days in advance of the date the permit is to be reopened. As such, the permit will be reopened thirty (30) days after receipt of this notice.
