## Notice of Decision: Revocation

Please be advised that on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Management, I have issued a decision regarding the enclosed matter. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-5(f) this revocation is effective fifteen (15) days after it is served. When served by U.S. mail, the order is effective eighteen (18) calendar days from the mailing of this notice pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-2(e).

If you wish to challenge this decision, IC 4-21.5-3-7 and IC 13-15-7-3 require that you file a petition for administrative review. This petition describing your intent must be submitted to the Office of Environmental Adjudication, 100 North Senate Avenue, Government Center North, Room 1049, Indianapolis, IN 46204, **within eighteen (18) calendar days from the mailing of this notice.** The filing of a petition for administrative review is complete on the earliest of the following dates that apply to the filing:

- (1) the date the document is delivered to the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA);
- (2) the date of the postmark on the envelope containing the document, if the document is mailed to OEA by U.S. mail; or
- (3) The date on which the document is deposited with a private carrier, as shown by receipt issued by the carrier, if the document is sent to the OEA by private carrier.

The petition must include facts demonstrating that you are either the applicant, a person aggrieved or adversely affected by the decision or otherwise entitled to review by law. Please identify the permit, decision, or other order for which you seek review by permit number, name of the applicant, location, date of this notice and all of the following:

- (1) the name and address of the person making the request;
- (2) the interest of the person making the request;
- (3) identification of any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (4) the reasons, with particularity, for the request;
- (5) the issues, with particularity, proposed for considerations at any hearing; and
- (6) identification of the terms and conditions which, in the judgment of the person making the request, would be appropriate in the case in question to satisfy the requirements of the law governing documents of the type issued by the Commissioner.

The letter from CTP, Division of Tube Processing Corporation, received on May 22, 2007, has been reviewed by the Indiana Department of Environmental Management Office of Air Quality (OAQ) and the City of Indianapolis Office of Environmental Services (OES). This letter requested that CTP, Division of Tube Processing Corporation, be issued a Registration for a fabricated metal products operation located at 3750 South Shelby Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46227.

During the application review process, OAQ and OES determined that CTP, Sheetmetal, located at 3555 Madison Avenue, Indianapolis, Indiana 46227, and CTP, Division of Tube Processing Corporation located at 3750 South Shelby Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46227 are operating as a single collocated source for air quality permitting purposes. This determination has been made because the plant sites are under common ownership and control, under the same Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) code, and are adjacent to one another.

CTP, Sheetmetal was issued an Exemption No. E097-23219-00438 on August 17, 2006. The emission units located at CTP, Sheetmetal are now combined into the Registration No. R097-23537-00593 for CTP, Division of Tube Processing Corporation. Because the emission units are now included in a Registration, the Exemption for CTP, Sheetmetal, E097-23219-00438, is no longer valid and must be revoked.

Pursuant to 326 IAC 2-1.1-9, any permit to construct or operate or any permit revision approval granted by the commissioner may be revoked for any cause that establishes in the judgment of the commissioner the fact that continuance of the permit or permit revision approval is not consistent with the purposes of 326 IAC 2. Because CTP, Sheetmetal is now combined into the Registration No. R097-23537-00593 for CTP, Division of Tube Processing Corporation, the Exemption No. E097-23219-00438 issued to CTP, Sheetmetal on August 17, 2006 is no longer the correct determination of the permitting level for this source. Therefore, Exemption No. E097-23219-00438, issued on August 17, 2006, is hereby revoked. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-5(a) and (b), this Revocation letter is effective in eighteen (18) days from the date of this letter.
